

Miller Clamp



overview

Miller clamp is a widely used general tool. It is mainly used for moving tube and coating of fibers, can handle most of the common application. Its handles use ergonomic design to make workers comfortable for long time operation.

Features

- Big hole: Stripping 1.6-3mm to 600-900 m buffer
- Middle hole: Stripping 600-900 m to 250 m jacket
- Small hole: Stripping 250 m-125 m fiber
- Pre-set at the factory, no adjustments needed;
- Will not scratch or nick glass fiber;
- All cutting surfaces have sophisticated mechanical tolerances to ensure a clean, smooth operation;
- Comfort-grip, ergonomic handles;
- Lock to hold tool closed when it is not in use.
